Lottery funding for four county community groups

Lottery funding for four county community groups

LOTTERY funding has been granted to four community groups in Herefordshire.

The Big Lottery Fund has granted almost £40,000 to groups in the county through its Awards for All programme.

The Growing Local is Going Local community interest company received £9,980 to run a series of cookery workshops.

The company works from Court Farm near Tillington where it has an educational garden.

School groups come to the farm and grow their own produce.

The new project will then allow pupils to cook recipes, using their own produce, in a kitchen onsite which has been developed in a shipping container, donated from the army camp.

Gibbs and Dandy donated wood and Window Wise donated oak windows.

The lottery money will buy equipment for the kitchen and also equipment to take to schools.

Whitney on Wye Village Hall received £10,000 to refurbish their toilets to enable the group to meet current health and safety requirements.

While Risbury Village Hall received £9,803 for its energy efficiency project. The group will use the funding to install insulation and double glazing in the hall.











The Ross Neighbourhood Plan Group was awarded £10,000 to undertake community consultation and analysis of these consultations, in order to produce a neighbourhood plan.

This will enable the community to input into the neighbourhood plan, ensuring future developments to the area best meet their needs.

Awards for All provides grants between £300 and £10,000 to voluntary and community organisations.
